This Week in Jewish History:

**(14 Shevat):** Yahrzeit of **Rabbi Yaakov Yehoshua Falk** (1680-1756), better known as the "Pnei Yehoshua," the title of his brilliant book of Talmudic commentary. Shevat 14 is also the yahrzeit of **Rabbi Aryeh Kaplan** (1934-1983), an American author and scholar who inspired thousands of Jews to return to Jewish observance. Rabbi Kaplan was a physicist, and applied the same analytical approach to the study of "metaphysics." The Jewish world mourned his untimely death at the age of 49.
