This Week in Jewish History:

(23 Av) Yahrzeit of **Rabbi Yaakov Yisrael Kanievsky** (1899-1985), known as the **Steipler Gaon**. He wrote a multi-volume Talmudic commentary, *Kehilos Yaakov*, which is studied widely today. He married the sister of the **Chazon Ish**, and later moved to Israel. His son, **Rabbi Chaim Kanievsky**, is a leading Torah authority in Israel today.
